At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. (a) STUDY.—The Under Secretary of Agriculture for Food Safety (in this section referred to as the "Under Secretary"), in coordination with the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, shall conduct a study regarding the public health threat of non-6 ambulatory pigs entering the food system. 7 (b) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Under Secretary shall submit 8 to Congress, and make publicly available, a report describing the results of the study referred to in subsection (a), including the impact on public health of the following 12 pathogens associated with nonambulatory pigs: 13 (1) Swine influenza viruses H1N1 and H3N2. 14 (2) Salmonella. 15 (3) Yersinia enterocolitica. 16 (4) Campylobacter. 17 (5) Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus.
