Add at the end of subtitle C of title XVII the following:

1 SEC. 1748. STRATEGY TO STRENGTHEN UNITED STATES-AR-

2	MENIA SECURITY COOPERATION.
3	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
4	gress that the United States has a responsibility to ensure
5	that the security and territorial integrity of the Republic
6	of Armenia are not jeopardized, including as a result of
7	Azerbaijani aggression, due to Armenia's decision to re-
8	duce its reliance on Russia for security and to freeze its
9	participation in the Russian-led Collective Security Treaty
10	Organization (CSTO).
11	(b) Development of Strategy.—
12	(1) In general.—Not later than 180 days
13	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
14	retary of Defense, with the concurrence of the Sec-
15	retary of State, and in coordination with the heads
16	of such other Federal agencies as the Secretary of
17	Defense considers appropriate, shall develop and
18	submit to the appropriate congressional committees
19	a strategy to strengthen security cooperation be-

1	tween the United States and the Republic of Arme-
2	nia and to deter further Azerbaijani aggression
3	against Armenia.
4	(2) Contents.—The strategy required under
5	paragraph (1) shall outline how the United States
6	Government will carry out the following:
7	(A) Provide greater logistical, intelligence
8	and training support for the Armed Forces of
9	Armenia;.
10	(B) Increase the scale and frequency of
11	joint United States-Armenia military exercises.
12	(C) Provide the Armenian Government
13	with greater access to military equipment pro-
14	duced in the United States while adopting suffi-
15	cient safeguards to protect sensitive United
16	States defense technology.
17	(D) Support international efforts, includ-
18	ing the European Union Monitoring Capacity to
19	Armenia, to monitor violations by Azerbaijan of
20	Armenia's sovereignty.
21	(3) FORM.—The strategy required under para-
22	graph (1) shall be submitted in unclassified form
23	but may include a classified annex.

1	(4) Appropriate congressional commit-
2	TEES.—In this section, the term "appropriate con-
3	gressional committees" means—
4	(A) the congressional defense committees;
5	(B) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of
6	the House of Representatives; and
7	(C) the Committee on Foreign Relations of
8	the Senate.
