At the end of subtitle J of title V, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 5 INTERNAL REVIEW OF BARRIERS PREVENTING
2	ETHNIC MINORITIES FROM ASCENDING TO
3	SENIOR LEADERSHIP ROLES.
4	(a) REVIEW REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Defense
5	shall conduct an in-depth internal review to identify bar-
6	riers preventing members of the Armed Forces who are
7	ethnic minorities from being promoted to positions as sen-
8	ior defense officials or senior military officers.
9	(b) Elements.—As part of the review under sub-
10	section (a), the Secretary of Defense shall—
11	(1) describe the steps that senior leaders within
12	the Department of Defense are taking to sustain
13	and retain diversity;
14	(2) describe potential barriers preventing mem-
15	bers of the Armed Forces who are ethnic minorities
16	from being promoted to positions as senior defense
17	officials or senior military officers;

1	(3) identify any structures and strategies that
2	have been implemented, or that are under develop-
3	ment, to equip leadership with the ability to manage
4	diversity, be accountable, and create an inclusive
5	work environment that cultivates innovation and op-
6	timization within the Department;
7	(4) describe any applicable policies and regula-
8	tions pertaining to equal opportunity and non-
9	discrimination within the Department;
10	(5) develop poicies and legislative recommenda-
11	tions for improving diversity among senior roles in
12	the Department of Defense and in each Armed
13	Force; and
14	(6) address such other matters as the Secretary
15	determines relevant.
16	(c) Report to Congress.—Not later than one year
17	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
18	of Defense shall submit to the appropriate congressional
19	committees a report on the results of the review conducted
20	under subsection (a).
21	(d) Appropriate Congressional Committees
22	DEFINED.—In this section the term "appropriate congres-
23	sional committees" means the following:

1	(1) The Committee on Armed Services and the
2	Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House of
3	Representatives.
4	(2) The Committee on Armed Services and the
5	Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate.
