Page 1348, insert after line 23 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 5806. REPORT ON REMOVAL OF SERVICE MEMBERS.

2 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 120 days
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act and monthly
4 thereafter, the Secretary of Homeland Security, in coordi-
5 nation with the Secretary of Veteran Affairs, the Sec-
6 retary of Defense, and the Secretary of State shall submit
7 to the Committees on the Judiciary of the House of Rep-
8 resentatives and the Senate, the Committees on Veteran
9 Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Senate,
10 and the Committees on Appropriations of the House of
11 Representatives and the Senate a report detailing how
12 many noncitizen service members, veterans and immediate
13 family members of service members were removed during
14 the period beginning on January 1, 2010, and ending on
15 the date of the report.

16 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection
17 (a) shall include the following for each person removed:

18 (1) the individual's name;

- 1 (2) the individual's address;
- 2 (3) the individual's contact information;
- 3 (4) any known U.S. citizen family members in
- 4 the U.S.;
- 5 (5) where the individual was removed to; and
- 6 (6) the reason for removal.

7 (c) GAO REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the
8 date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
9 of the United States shall update GAO report number-
10 19-416 to identify progress made and further actions
11 needed to better handle, identify, and track cases involving
12 veterans.

13 (d) CONFIDENTIALITY.—The report under subsection
14 (a) may not be published and shall be exempt from disclo-
15 sure under section 552(b)(3)(B) of title 5, United States
16 Code.
