

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ESPAILLAT OF NEW YORK**

At the end of title V, add the following:

1 **SEC. 5** \_\_\_\_ . **BOLLARD INSTALLATION GRANT PROGRAM.**

2 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—Not later than 1 year after  
3 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-  
4 portation shall establish a program through the Federal  
5 Aviation Administration to assist bollard installation  
6 projects—

7 (1) located within 25 miles of airports; and

8 (2) designed to prevent pedestrian injuries and  
9 acts of terrorism in areas utilized by large numbers  
10 of pedestrians.

11 (b) **GRANT AUTHORITY.**—In carrying out the pro-  
12 gram established under subsection (a), the Secretary may  
13 award a grant, on a competitive basis, to a local govern-  
14 ment entity.

15 (c) **APPLICATION.**—To be eligible for a grant under  
16 this section, a local government entity shall submit to the  
17 Secretary an application at such time, in such form, and  
18 containing such information as the Secretary determines  
19 appropriate, which shall include, at a minimum—

1           (1) a description of the proposed bollard instal-  
2           lation project to be carried out;

3           (2) a description of the pedestrian injury or ter-  
4           rorism risks with respect to the proposed installation  
5           area; and

6           (3) an analysis of how the proposed project will  
7           mitigate such risks.

8           (d) GRANT USES.—A recipient of a grant awarded  
9           under this section may use the proceeds of such grant only  
10          for a bollard installation project.

11          (e) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the  
12          costs of a bollard installation project assisted with a grant  
13          awarded under this section may not exceed 100 percent.

14          (f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
15          authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Trans-  
16          portation to carry out this section \$5,000,000 for each of  
17          fiscal years 2018 through 2027.

18          (g) BOLLARD INSTALLATION PROJECT DEFINED.—  
19          In this section, the term “bollard installation project”  
20          means a project to install raised concrete or metal posts  
21          on a sidewalk adjacent to a roadway that are designed  
22          to slow or stop a motor vehicle.
