

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-70
OFFERED BY MR. ESPAILLAT OF NEW YORK

Add at the end of subtitle G of title X the following
new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . BOLLARD INSTALLATION GRANT PROGRAM.**

2 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—Not later than 1 year after
3 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
4 shall establish a program to assist bollard installation
5 projects—

6 (1) located on a facility or property of the De-
7 partment of Defense; and

8 (2) designed to prevent pedestrian injuries and
9 acts of terrorism in areas utilized by large numbers
10 of pedestrians.

11 (b) **GRANT AUTHORITY.**—In carrying out the pro-
12 gram established under subsection (a), the Secretary may
13 award a grant, on a competitive basis, to a local govern-
14 ment entity.

15 (c) **APPLICATION.**—To be eligible for a grant under
16 this section, a local government entity shall submit to the
17 Secretary an application at such time, in such form, and

1 containing such information as the Secretary determines
2 appropriate, which shall include, at a minimum—

3 (1) a description of the proposed bollard instal-
4 lation project to be carried out;

5 (2) a description of the pedestrian injury or ter-
6 rorism risks with respect to the proposed installation
7 area; and

8 (3) an analysis of how the proposed project will
9 mitigate such risks.

10 (d) GRANT USES.—A recipient of a grant awarded
11 under this section may use the proceeds of such grant only
12 for a bollard installation project.

13 (e) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the
14 costs of a bollard installation project assisted with a grant
15 awarded under this section may not exceed 100 percent.

16 (f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
17 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Defense
18 to carry out this section \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2019.

19 (g) BOLLARD INSTALLATION PROJECT DEFINED.—
20 In this section, the term “bollard installation project”
21 means a project to install raised concrete or metal posts
22 on a sidewalk adjacent to a roadway that are designed
23 to slow or stop a motor vehicle.
