

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-

OFFERED BY MR. MOYLAN OF GUAM

At the end of subtitle A of title XXVIII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28__ . REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO BUILDING IN-**
2 **FRASTRUCTURE RELATING TO THE GUAM**
3 **MISSILE DEFENSE SYSTEM.**

4 (a) ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN
5 GUAM.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Economic Adjustment
7 Committee (established under Executive Order
8 12788 (57 Fed. Reg. 2213)) may make grants,
9 enter into cooperative agreements, or supplement
10 funds available under Federal programs not admin-
11 istered by the Department of Defense to assist local
12 governments in Guam to address the effects of be-
13 ginning to build infrastructure relating to the Guam
14 missile defense system.

15 (2) SELECTION.—The Economic Adjustment
16 Committee (established under Executive Order
17 12788 (57 Fed. Reg. 2213)), in coordination with

1 the lead senior defense official for Guam, shall select
2 recipients of grants under this subsection.

3 (b) STRATEGIC PLAN.—The Under Secretary of De-
4 fense for Acquisition and Sustainment shall develop and
5 implement and a strategic plan to address the effects de-
6 scribed in subsection (a), including steps for coordinating
7 components of the Department in carrying out the stra-
8 tegic plan.

9 (c) REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than
10 April 1, 2025, the Secretary of Defense, acting through
11 the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and
12 Sustainment and in coordination with the lead senior de-
13 fense official for Guam, shall submit to Congress a report
14 that includes the following:

15 (1) A description of any assistance provided
16 under subsection (a).

17 (2) A description of the strategic plan required
18 under subsection (b).

19 (3) Such recommendations as the Secretary
20 considers appropriate with respect to improvements
21 to be made to any infrastructure built, or construc-
22 tion plans for such infrastructure, relating to the
23 Guam missile defense system.

24 (d) PROGRESS REPORTS.—Not later than April 1,
25 2025, and annually thereafter for three years, the Sec-

1 retary of Defense, acting through the Under Secretary and
2 in coordination with the lead senior defense official for
3 Guam, shall submit to Congress a report setting forth the
4 following:

5 (1) A description of the progress made during
6 the fiscal year preceding the date of the report in
7 implementing the strategic plan.

8 (2) A description of any additional actions
9 taken or planned to address limitations on infra-
10 structure built, or construction plans for such infra-
11 structure, relating to the Guam missile defense sys-
12 tem.

13 (3) A list of significant modifications to road-
14 ways and entry and exit points for military installa-
15 tions and closures or expansions of military installa-
16 tions during the fiscal year preceding the date of the
17 report, including economic factors that will affect
18 Guam and energy effects of infrastructure built, or
19 construction plans for such infrastructure, relating
20 to the Guam missile defense system.
