

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4776, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MOYLAN OF GUAM

Add at the end the following new section:

1 SEC. ____ . RESTORING PRIVATE LAND OWNERSHIP.

2 (a) TRANSFER OF LAND OWNERSHIP.—Section 1 of
3 the Act of November 13, 2000, entitled “An Act to amend
4 the Organic Act of Guam, and for other purposes” (Public
5 Law 106–504; 40 U.S.C. 521 note) is amended by adding
6 at the end the following new subsection:

7 “(g) TRANSFER FOR RESTORATION OF OWNER-
8 SHIP.—The ‘public purpose’ requirement under subsection
9 (b) shall not apply with respect to any transfer of excess
10 real property that the Government of Guam shall subse-
11 quently transfer to the original landowner or to the heirs
12 of such person.”.

13 (b) OVERSIGHT.—Not more than 180 days after the
14 date of enactment of this Act, the Government of Guam
15 shall—

16 (1) establish a process to transfer excess real
17 property described in subsection (g) of section 1 of
18 the Act of November 13, 2000, as added by sub-
19 section (a) of this section; and

1 (2) transmit to the Committee on Natural Re-
2 sources of the House of Representatives and the
3 Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of the
4 Senate a report describing such process.

5 (c) NATIONAL SECURITY REVIEW.—With respect to
6 any excess real property received by an individual under
7 subsection (g) of section 1 of the Act of November 13,
8 2000, as added by subsection (a) of this section—

9 (1) any sale of such property by that individual
10 to a foreign person, other than such a person that
11 is an heir of such original landowner, is a covered
12 transaction for purposes of section 721 of the De-
13 fense Production Act of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4565); and

14 (2) the Committee on Foreign Investment in
15 the United States shall initiate a review of such
16 transaction under section 721(b)(1)(A) of such Act.
