3	(a) In General.—Section 203(b)(2) of the Immi-
4	gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(b)(2)) is
5	amended by adding at the end the following:
6	"(D) Exception.—Notwithstanding sub-
7	paragraph (B), the requirements of subpara-
8	graph (A) that an immigrant's services in the
9	sciences, arts, professions, or business be
10	sought by an employer in the United States
11	shall not apply to immigrants (and the parents,
12	spouses, and children of such immigrants if ac-
13	companying or following to join) who—
14	"(i) are citizens of Russia;
15	"(ii) have earned a masters or doc-
16	toral degree in the United States or an
17	equivalent foreign degree in a field involv-
18	ing science, technology, engineering, or

1	mathematics, including but not limited to
2	degrees relevant to the following fields: Ad-
3	vanced Computing, Advanced Engineering
4	Materials, Advanced Gas Turbine Engine
5	Technologies, Advanced Manufacturing,

- graph (D) of section 203(b)(2).".
