TITLE III—AEROSPACE WORKFORCE

Subtitle A—Growing the Talent Pool

Sec . University Innovation Pilot Program

In general – the Secretary of Transportation may establish a polit program under which the sponsors of public-use airports may use funds made available under section 48105 of title 49, United States Code for use at up to 5 airports to carry out –

- 1. The constructions or modification of infrastructure to facilitate aviation programs that provide opportunities for aviation related careers and training to students at universities.
- 2. Activities relating to program operations, including start-up costs.

Eligibility--. A public-use airport is eligible for participation in the pilot program under this section if the Secretary finds that funds made available under this section would support—

- 1. Expanding pathways for careers in aviation
- 2. Partnerships with universities
- 3. Innovation programs that will recruit and train future pilots.

SUNSET.—The pilot program established under subsection X shall sunset 5 years after the date of enactment of this Act.
