

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54**  
**OFFERED BY MR. FALLON OF TEXAS**

At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 12\_\_ . EXTENSION AND MODIFICATION OF ANNUAL RE-**  
2 **PORT ON MILITARY POWER OF IRAN.**

3 (a) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—Subsection (b) of  
4 section 1245 of the National Defense Authorization Act  
5 for Fiscal Year 2010 (Public Law 111-84) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (2)(D), by inserting after  
7 “Iran’s conventional forces” the following: “and  
8 Iran’s unconventional or parallel military forces”;

9 (2) in paragraph (3)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “Iranian”  
11 and inserting “Islamic”;

12 (B) in subparagraph (G), by striking the  
13 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

14 (C) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(H) an assessment of the military power  
16 of Iranian proxies and partners, including  
17 Hizballah, Hamas, Palestine Islamic Jihad,  
18 Ansar Allah, and Iraqi and Syrian proxies.”;

19 (3) in paragraph (4)—

1 (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking “mis-  
2 sile launch sites” and inserting “missile launch  
3 and storage sites”;

4 (B) in subparagraph (C), by striking “;  
5 and” at the end;

6 (C) in subparagraph (D), by striking the  
7 period at the end and inserting a semicolon;  
8 and

9 (D) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(E) an assessment of Iran’s space launch  
11 vehicle program and the ability of Iran to use  
12 those technologies to develop and field an inter-  
13 continental ballistic missile;

14 “(F) a detailed analysis of the effectiveness  
15 of Iran’s drone forces; and

16 “(F) the status of efforts to protect Euro-  
17 pean allies and United States forces stationed  
18 in Europe from Iranian missile attacks.”;

19 (4) in paragraph (7), by inserting “the People’s  
20 Republic of China,” before “Cuba”; and

21 (5) by adding at the end the following:

22 “(9) An assessment of the use of civilians pro-  
23 tected as such by the law of war to shield military  
24 objectives from attack, by groups which are sup-  
25 ported by Iran and designated by the United States

1 as foreign terrorist organizations and regional mili-  
2 tary groups, including Hezbollah, Hamas, the  
3 Houthis, and the Special Groups in Iraq, in par-  
4 ticular those forces as having been assessed as to be  
5 willing to carry out terrorist operations on behalf of  
6 Iran or in response to a military attack by another  
7 country on Iran.

8 “(10) An assessment of how Iran would utilize  
9 additional resources to further activities described in  
10 paragraphs (1) through (9).”.

11 (b) DEFINITIONS.—Subsection (c) of such section is  
12 amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (1)(B) to read as follows:

14 “(B) all branches and sub-branches of  
15 Iran’s national army or Artesh, such as its  
16 ground forces, air force, navy, and air defense  
17 forces as well as most branches of its parallel  
18 military, and the Islamic Revolutionary Guard  
19 Corps excluding its Quds-Force.”; and

20 (2) in paragraph (2)(B)(i), by striking “Ira-  
21 nian” and inserting “Islamic”.

22 (c) TERMINATION.—Subsection (d) of such section is  
23 amended by striking “December 31, 2025” and inserting  
24 “December 31, 2030”.
