

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2
OFFERED BY MR. FEENSTRA OF IOWA

Page 213, insert after line 17 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 TITLE IX—SARAH’S LAW
2 SEC. 901. MANDATORY DETENTION OF CERTAIN ALIENS
3 CHARGED WITH A CRIME RESULTING IN
4 DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY.

5 Section 236(e) of the Immigration and Nationality
6 Act (8 U.S.C. 1226(e)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)—

8 (A) in subparagraphs (A) and (B), by
9 striking the comma at the end of each subpara-
10 graph and inserting a semicolon;

11 (B) in subparagraph (C)—

12 (i) by striking “sentence” and insert-
13 ing “sentenced”; and

14 (ii) by striking “, or” and inserting a
15 semicolon;

16 (C) in subparagraph (D), by striking the
17 comma at the end and inserting “; or”; and

18 (D) by inserting after subparagraph (D)
19 the following:

1 “(E)(i)(I) was not inspected and admitted
2 into the United States;

3 “(II) held a nonimmigrant visa (or other
4 documentation authorizing admission into the
5 United States as a nonimmigrant) that has
6 been revoked under section 221(i); or

7 “(III) is described in section
8 237(a)(1)(C)(i); and

9 “(ii) has been charged by a prosecuting au-
10 thority in the United States with any crime
11 that resulted in the death or serious bodily in-
12 jury (as defined in section 1365(h)(3) of title
13 18, United States Code) of another person,”;
14 and

15 (2) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(3) NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.—Upon en-
17 counterling or gaining knowledge of an alien de-
18 scribed in paragraph (1), the Assistant Secretary of
19 Homeland Security for Immigration and Customs
20 Enforcement shall make reasonable efforts—

21 “(A) to obtain information from law en-
22 forcement agencies and from other available
23 sources regarding the identity of any victims of
24 the crimes for which such alien was charged or
25 convicted; and

1 “(B) to provide the victim or, if the victim
2 is deceased, a parent, guardian, spouse, or clos-
3 est living relative of such victim, with informa-
4 tion, on a timely and ongoing basis, including—

5 “(i) the alien’s full name, aliases, date
6 of birth, and country of nationality;

7 “(ii) the alien’s immigration status
8 and criminal history;

9 “(iii) the alien’s custody status and
10 any changes related to the alien’s custody;
11 and

12 “(iv) a description of any efforts by
13 the United States Government to remove
14 the alien from the United States.”.

15 **SEC. 902. SAVINGS PROVISION.**

16 Nothing in this title, or the amendments made by this
17 title, may be construed to limit the rights of crime victims
18 under any other provision of law, including section 3771
19 of title 18, United States Code.
