

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-**

**OFFERED BY MR. NUNN OF IOWA**

Add at the end of subtitle G of title XXVIII, the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28\_\_\_. REPORT ON UNDERUTILIZED AIR NATIONAL**  
2 **GUARD AIRFIELD INFRASTRUCTURE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary of the  
5 Air Force shall, in consultation with the Chief of the Na-  
6 tional Guard Bureau and the Commander of United  
7 States Strategic Command, submit to the congressional  
8 defense committees a report evaluating the feasibility, in-  
9 frastructure readiness, and cost-benefits of co-locating  
10 permanent, manned flying missions at Air National Guard  
11 installations that currently possess active runways but  
12 lack manned active aircraft.

13 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required under sub-  
14 section (a) shall include the following:

15 (1) An inventory of Air National Guard instal-  
16 lations described in subsection (a) that possess ac-  
17 tive runway infrastructure of 9,000 feet or greater,

1 secure military enclaves, and proximity to regional  
2 training corridors or geographic commands.

3 (2) An assessment of the capacity of such joint-  
4 use commercial airfield infrastructure, including  
5 taxiways and secure ramp space, to host permanent  
6 or distributed strategic assets.

7 (3) An evaluation of the workforce readiness  
8 and technical expertise, including cyber, intelligence,  
9 and remotely piloted aircraft operations, to support  
10 advanced manned flying missions.

11 (4) An assessment of alternative or distributed  
12 basing options required to support strategic long-  
13 range strike systems in the event that total procure-  
14 ment exceeds the initial program of record.
