

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**57**

**OFFERED BY MS. FINKENAUER OF IOWA**

At the end of subtitle B of title II, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 2\_\_\_ . MODIFICATION OF MECHANISMS FOR EXPE-**  
2 **DITED ACCESS TO TECHNICAL TALENT AND**  
3 **EXPERTISE AT ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS.**

4 Section 217 of the National Defense Authorization  
5 Act for Fiscal Year 2018 (Public Law 115–91; 10 U.S.C.  
6 2358 note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting “train-  
8 ing,” after “management,”;

9 (2) in subsection (e)—

10 (A) in paragraph (28) by striking “Infra-  
11 structure resilience” and inserting “Additive  
12 manufacturing”;

13 (B) by redesignating paragraph (30) as  
14 paragraph (33); and

15 (C) by inserting after paragraph (29) the  
16 following new paragraphs:

17 “(30) Corrosion prevention and control.

1           “(31) Advanced manufacturing for metal cast-  
2           ing.

3           “(32) 3D and virtual technology training plat-  
4           forms.”;

5           (3) by redesignating subsections (f) and (g) as  
6           subsection (g) and (h), respectively;

7           (4) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-  
8           lowing new subsection:

9           “(f) REQUIREMENT TO ESTABLISH CONSORTIA.—

10           “(1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out subsection  
11           (a)(1)—

12                   “(A) the Secretary of Defense shall seek to  
13                   establish at least one multi-institution consor-  
14                   tium through the Office of the Secretary of De-  
15                   fense;

16                   “(B) the Secretary of the Army shall seek  
17                   to establish at least one multi-institution con-  
18                   sortium through the Army;

19                   “(C) the Secretary of the Navy shall seek  
20                   to establish at least one multi-institution con-  
21                   sortium through the Navy; and

22                   “(D) the Secretary of the Air Force shall  
23                   seek to establish at least one multi-institution  
24                   consortium through the Air Force.

1           “(2) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than Sep-  
2           tember 30, 2022, the Secretary of Defense shall sub-  
3           mit to the congressional defense committees a report  
4           on the status of the efforts to establish consortia  
5           under paragraph (1).”; and

6           (5) in subsection (g), as so redesignated, by  
7           striking “2022” and inserting “2026”.
