

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-27**  
**TEXT OF HOUSE AMENDMENT TO S.1318**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MASSIE OF KENTUCKY**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

**SEC. . REPEAL OF EXPANDED DEFINITION OF ELECTRONIC  
COMMUNICATION SERVICE PROVIDER.**

(a) **REPEAL OF EXPANDED DEFINITION OF  
ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE PROVIDER.—**  
Section 701(b)(4) of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of  
1978 (50 U.S.C. 1881(b)(4)) is amended—

(1) in subparagraph (F)—

(A) by striking “custodian”; and

(B) by striking “(D), or (E)” and inserting “or  
(D)”;

(2) by striking subparagraph (E);

(3) in subparagraph (D), by striking the semicolon and  
inserting “; or”; and

(4) by redesignating subparagraph (F) as subparagraph  
(E).

(b) **DEFINITION WITH RESPECT TO PROTECTION OF  
PERSONS ASSISTING THE GOVERNMENT.—**Section  
801(6) of such Act (50 U.S.C. 1885(6)) is amended—

(1) in subparagraph (G)—

(A) by striking “custodian,”; and

(B) by striking “(E), or (F)” and inserting “or  
(E)”;

(2) by striking subparagraph (E);

(3) in subparagraph (F), by striking the semicolon and inserting “; or”; and

(4) by redesignating subparagraphs (F) and (G) as subparagraphs (E) and (F) respectively.

(c) TREATMENT OF CERTAIN SECTION 702 DIRECTIVES.— Any directive issued pursuant to section 702(i) of such Act (50 U.S.C. 1881a(i)) to a person who was considered an electronic communication service provider pursuant to section 701(b)(4) of such Act (50 U.S.C. 1881(b)(4)) as such section was in effect during the period beginning on April 20, 2024, and ending on the date of the enactment of this Act, but is not an electronic communication service provider pursuant to such section as in effect after the date of the enactment of this Act, shall be considered null and void.
