8 It is the sense of Congress that—

9 (1) United States citizens have a right to clean 10 air, clean water, and the conservation of the natural, 11 scenic, historic, and esthetic values of the environ-12 ment;

(2) clean air, clean water, and environmental
conservation are necessary for the health and
wellbeing of United States citizens and the national
economy;

17 (3) clean air, clean water, and environmental18 conservation are a national priority;

(4) existing laws at both the State and Federal
 level protect these rights; and

3 (5) the United States should continue to pro4 vide sustainable access to clean water and clean air
5 and make concerted efforts to conserve the natural,
6 scenic, historic, and esthetic values of the environ7 ment.
