Amendment to Rules Committee Print 117–54 Offered by Mr. Fitzpatrick of Pennsylvania

Add to the end of title LVIII of Division E the following:

1 SEC. 5806. NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULA-2 TIONS FOR PFAS. 3 (a) NATIONAL DRINKING WATER REGULATIONS.— 4 Section 1412(b) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42) U.S.C. 300g-1(b)) is amended by adding at the end the 5 following: 6 ((16))Perfluoroalkyl 7 AND 8 POLYFLUOROALKYL SUBSTANCES.— 9 "(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one 10 year after the date of enactment of this para-11 graph, the Administrator shall, after notice and 12 opportunity for public comment, promulgate a 13 national primary drinking water regulation for 14 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances,

which shall, at a minimum, include standards
for—

1	"(i) perfluorooctanoic acid (commonly
2	referred to as 'PFOA'); and
3	"(ii) perfluorooctane sulfonic acid
4	(commonly referred to as 'PFOS').
5	"(B) Alternative procedures.—
6	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1
7	year after the validation by the Adminis-
8	trator of an equally effective quality con-
9	trol and testing procedure to ensure com-
10	pliance with the national primary drinking
11	water regulation promulgated under sub-
12	paragraph (A) to measure the levels de-
13	scribed in clause (ii) or other methods to
14	detect and monitor perfluoroalkyl and
15	polyfluoroalkyl substances in drinking
16	water, the Administrator shall add the pro-
17	cedure or method as an alternative to the
18	quality control and testing procedure de-
19	scribed in such national primary drinking
20	water regulation by publishing the proce-
21	dure or method in the Federal Register in
22	accordance with section $1401(1)(D)$.
23	"(ii) LEVELS DESCRIBED.—The levels
24	referred to in clause (i) are—

1	"(I) the level of a perfluoroalkyl
2	or polyfluoroalkyl substance;
3	"(II) the total levels of
4	perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl sub-
5	stances; and
6	"(III) the total levels of organic
7	fluorine.
8	"(C) INCLUSIONS.—The Administrator
9	may include a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
10	substance or class of perfluoroalkyl or
11	polyfluoroalkyl substances on—
12	"(i) the list of contaminants for con-
13	sideration of regulation under paragraph
14	(1)(B)(i), in accordance with such para-
15	graph; and
16	"(ii) the list of unregulated contami-
17	nants to be monitored under section
18	1445(a)(2)(B)(i), in accordance with such
19	section.
20	"(D) MONITORING.—When establishing
21	monitoring requirements for public water sys-
22	tems as part of a national primary drinking
23	water regulation under subparagraph (A) or
24	subparagraph (G)(ii), the Administrator shall
25	tailor the monitoring requirements for public

1 water systems that do not detect or are reliably 2 and consistently below the maximum contaminant level (as defined in section 1418(b)(2)(B)) 3 4 for the perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-5 class stance of perfluoroalkyl \mathbf{or} or 6 polyfluoroalkyl substances subject to the na-7 tional primary drinking water regulation.

8 "(E) HEALTH PROTECTION.—The national 9 primary drinking water regulation promulgated 10 under subparagraph (A) shall be protective of 11 the health of subpopulations at greater risk, as 12 described in section 1458.

13 "(F) Health risk reduction and cost 14 ANALYSIS.—In meeting the requirements of 15 paragraph (3)(C), the Administrator may rely 16 on information available to the Administrator 17 with respect to more specific one or 18 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances to 19 extrapolate reasoned conclusions regarding the 20 health effects of class risks and of a 21 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances of 22 which the specific perfluoroalkyl or 23 polyfluoroalkyl substances are a part.

24 "(G) REGULATION OF ADDITIONAL SUB25 STANCES.—

1	"(i) Determination.—The Adminis-
2	trator shall make a determination under
3	paragraph (1)(A), using the criteria de-
4	scribed in clauses (i) through (iii) of that
5	paragraph, whether to include a
6	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance
7	or class of perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
8	substances in the national primary drink-
9	ing water regulation under subparagraph
10	(A) not later than 18 months after the
11	later of—
12	"(I) the date on which the
13	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-
14	stance or class of perfluoroalkyl or
15	polyfluoroalkyl substances is listed on
16	the list of contaminants for consider-
17	ation of regulation under paragraph
18	(1)(B)(i); and
19	"(II) the date on which—
20	"(aa) the Administrator has
21	received the results of monitoring
22	under section $1445(a)(2)(B)$ for
23	the perfluoroalkyl or
24	polyfluoroalkyl substance or class

1	of perfluoroalkyl or
2	polyfluoroalkyl substances; or
3	"(bb) the Administrator has
4	received reliable water data or
5	water monitoring surveys for the
6	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
7	substance or class of
8	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
9	substances from a Federal or
10	State agency that the Adminis-
11	trator determines to be of a qual-
12	ity sufficient to make a deter-
13	mination under paragraph
14	(1)(A).
15	"(ii) PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REG-
16	ULATIONS.—
17	"(I) IN GENERAL.—For each
18	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-
19	stance or class of perfluoroalkyl or
20	polyfluoroalkyl substances that the
21	Administrator determines to regulate
22	under clause (i), the Administrator—
23	"(aa) not later than 18
24	months after the date on which
25	the Administrator makes the de-

2	tional primary drinking water
3	regulation for the perfluoroalkyl
4	or polyfluoroalkyl substance or
5	class of perfluoroalkyl or
6	polyfluoroalkyl substances; and
7	"(bb) may publish the pro-
8	posed national primary drinking
9	water regulation described in
10	item (aa) concurrently with the
11	publication of the determination
12	to regulate the perfluoroalkyl or
13	polyfluoroalkyl substance or class
14	of perfluoroalkyl or
15	polyfluoroalkyl substances.
16	"(II) DEADLINE.—
17	"(aa) IN GENERAL.—Not
18	later than 1 year after the date
19	on which the Administrator pub-
20	lishes a proposed national pri-
21	mary drinking water regulation
22	under clause (i)(I) and subject to
23	item (bb), the Administrator

24 shall take final action on the pro-

1	posed national primary drinking
2	water regulation.
3	"(bb) EXTENSION.—The
4	Administrator, on publication of
5	notice in the Federal Register,
6	may extend the deadline under
7	item (aa) by not more than 6
8	months.
9	"(H) HEALTH ADVISORY.—
10	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Subject to clause
11	(ii), the Administrator shall publish a
12	health advisory under paragraph $(1)(F)$ for
13	a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-
14	stance or class of perfluoroalkyl or
15	polyfluoroalkyl substances not subject to a
16	national primary drinking water regulation
17	not later than 1 year after the later of—
18	"(I) the date on which the Ad-
19	ministrator finalizes a toxicity value
20	for the perfluoroalkyl or
21	polyfluoroalkyl substance or class of
22	perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-
23	stances; and
24	"(II) the date on which the Ad-
25	ministrator validates an effective qual-

1ity control and testing procedure for2the perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl3substance or class of perfluoroalkyl or4polyfluoroalkyl substances.

"(ii) WAIVER.—The Administrator 5 6 may waive the requirements of clause (i) 7 with respect perfluoroalkyl to a or 8 polyfluoroalkyl substance \mathbf{or} class of 9 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances if the Administrator determines 10 11 that there is a substantial likelihood that 12 the perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl sub-13 class of perfluoroalkyl stance \mathbf{or} -or 14 polyfluoroalkyl substances will not occur in 15 drinking water with sufficient frequency to 16 justify the publication of a health advisory, 17 and publishes such determination, includ-18 ing the information and analysis used, and 19 basis for, such determination, in the Fed-20 eral Register.".

(b) ENFORCEMENT.—Notwithstanding any other
provision of law, the Administrator of the Environmental
Protection Agency may not impose financial penalties for
the violation of a national primary drinking water regulation (as defined in section 1401 of the Safe Drinking

U.S.C. 300f)) with respect to 1 Water Act (42 a 2 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance or class of 3 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substances for which a national primary drinking water regulation has been pro-4 mulgated under section 1412(b)(16) of the Safe Drinking 5 Water Act earlier than the date that is 5 years after the 6 date on which the Administrator promulgates the national 7 primary drinking water regulation. 8
