

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. FITZGERALD OF WISCONSIN

Page 770, line 24, strike “Developments in the military doctrine,” and insert “An assessment of developments in the military doctrine, force structure, training,”.

Page 771, line 2, strike the period at the end and insert “, including Russian adaptation based on Russian operations in Ukraine.”.

Page 772, line 19, strike the period at the end and insert “, including Russia’s relationship with Hamas and other regional terrorist organizations and Russia’s current military posture and activities in Syria.”.

Page 773, line 17, strike “or missile systems” and insert “, missile systems, one-way attack unmanned aerial systems, and other significant weapons systems,”.

Page 774, line 5, insert “air and” before “missile”.

Page 774, line 7, insert “air and” before “missile”.

Page 775, after line 20, insert the following:

- 1 (28) An assessment of Russia’s hybrid warfare
- 2 strategy and capabilities, including—

1 (A) Russia's information warfare strategy
2 and capabilities, including the use of misin-
3 formation, disinformation, and propaganda in
4 social and traditional media;

5 (B) Russia's financing of political parties,
6 think tanks, media organizations, and academic
7 institutions;

8 (C) Russia's malicious cyber activities;

9 (D) Russia's use of coercive economic
10 tools, including sanctions, market access, and
11 differential pricing, especially in energy exports;

12 (E) Russia's use of criminal networks and
13 corruption to achieve political objectives;

14 (F) Russian sabotage and other active
15 measures in Western countries; and

16 (G) Russian intelligence gathering and re-
17 cruitment of assets, including journalists and
18 media personalities.

19 (29) A description of Russian circumvention of
20 Western sanctions and export controls targeting the
21 Russian military industrial base, including the role
22 of the People's Republic of China and other adver-
23 sarial state and non-state actors.

24 (30) An assessment of developments in security
25 cooperation between Russia and the People's Repub-

1 lic of China and any threats that cooperation poses
2 to the United States and allies and partners of the
3 United States.

Page 775, line 21, redesignate paragraph (28) as
paragraph (31).
