

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE**  
**PRINT 116-22**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ROSE OF NEW YORK**

Page 79, line 19, insert “, the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate, and the Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Representatives” after “congressional intelligence committees”.

At the end of title VII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7\_\_\_\_. ASSESSMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY**  
2 **VULNERABILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH CER-**  
3 **TAIN RETIRED AND FORMER PERSONNEL OF**  
4 **THE INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY.**

5 (a) ASSESSMENT REQUIRED.—Not later than the  
6 date that is 120 days after submission of the report re-  
7 quired under section 704 of this Act, and annually there-  
8 after, the Director of National Intelligence, in coordination  
9 with the Under Secretary of Homeland Security for Intel-  
10 ligence and Analysis, the Director of the Federal Bureau  
11 of Investigation, the Director of the Central Intelligence  
12 Agency, and the Director of the Defense Counterintel-

1 ligence and Security Agency, shall submit to the appro-  
2 priate congressional committees an assessment of the  
3 homeland security vulnerabilities associated with retired  
4 and former personnel of intelligence community providing  
5 covered intelligence assistance.

6 (b) FORM.—The assessment under subsection (a)  
7 may be submitted in classified form.

8 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-  
10 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-  
11 mittees” means—

12 (A) the congressional intelligence commit-  
13 tees;

14 (B) the Committee on Homeland Security  
15 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate; and

16 (C) the Committee on Homeland Security  
17 of the House of Representatives.

18 (2) COVERED INTELLIGENCE ASSISTANCE.—  
19 The term “covered intelligence assistance” has the  
20 meaning given that term in section 704 of this Act.
