

AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE PRINT 117-13
OFFERED BY MR. FORTENBERRY OF NEBRASKA

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 12** ____.

2 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

3 (1) The former President of Afghanistan
4 Ashraf Ghani’s refusal to vacate his office con-
5 stitutes a dereliction of duty, leaving Afghanistan
6 without adequate leadership to resist the resurgence
7 of the Taliban, leading to the deaths of an unknown
8 number of Afghan citizens and thirteen United
9 States service members.

10 (2) The Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of
11 Afghanistan to Tajikistan Mohammad Zahir Aghbar
12 requested the International Criminal Police Organi-
13 zation apprehend former President of Afghanistan
14 Ashraf Ghani for embezzlement from the treasury of
15 Afghanistan valued at approximately \$169,000,000.

16 (3) The United States has provided
17 \$145,000,000,000 to the Government of Afghani-
18 stan’s reconstruction efforts since 2001, including

1 \$17,280,000,000 in on-budget assistance to the Gov-
2 ernment of Afghanistan.

3 (4) Potentially enriching himself at the expense
4 of the security of American personnel is a violation
5 of the trust the United States placed in former
6 President of Afghanistan Ashraf Ghani and his ad-
7 ministration.

8 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—That it is the sense of
9 the House of Representatives that—

10 (1) notwithstanding section 221 of the Immi-
11 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1201), the
12 Secretary of State should deny a visa to, and the
13 Secretary of Homeland Security should deny admis-
14 sion or parole into the United States for, former
15 President of Afghanistan Ashraf Ghani;

16 (2) pursuant to section 221(i) of the Immigra-
17 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1201(i)), the
18 issuing consular officer, the Secretary of State, or
19 the Secretary of Homeland Security (or a designee
20 of any such officer or Secretary) should revoke any
21 visa or other entry documentation issued to former
22 President of Afghanistan Ashraf Ghani, regardless
23 of when the visa or other documentation was issued;
24 and

1 (3) a revocation described in paragraph (2)
2 should take effect immediately and shall automati-
3 cally cancel any other valid visa or entry documenta-
4 tion that is in the alien's possession
