(c) PROHIBITING RECEIPT OF INCOME FROM ANTI TRUST DEFENDANTS.—

(1) PROHIBITION.—An individual whose supervisor is required to submit a report with respect to
the individual under subsection (a) may not receive
compensation from a source that is a defendant in
a case commenced by the United States under any
of the antitrust laws (as defined in the 1st section
of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. 12)).

10 (2) WAIVER.—An individual may obtain a waiv-11 er of paragraph (1) from the Committee on House 12 Administration of the House of Representatives or 13 the Committee on Rules and Administration of the 14 Senate (as the case may be) if the individual cer-15 tifies to the Committee that the aggregate amount 16 of compensation the individual will receive from a 17 source described in paragraph (1) during the cal-18 endar year will not exceed \$25,000.

19 (d) FAILURE TO MEET REQUIREMENTS.—A super-20 visor described in subsection (a) who fails to submit a re-

port required under this section, and an individual who
 violates subsection (c), shall be subject to such sanction
 as may be imposed by the Select Committee on Ethics of
 the Senate or the Committee on Ethics of the House of
 Representatives, as the case may be.
