

**AMENDMENT TO H. RES. 326, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MS. FOXX OF NORTH CAROLINA**

Strike all after the resolved clause and insert the following:

1       That the House of Representatives—

2               (1) reaffirms that it is the law of the United  
3       States to prohibit the use of United States taxpayer  
4       dollars for certain assessed or voluntary contribu-  
5       tions to the United Nations or its specialized agen-  
6       cies regarding the status of the Palestinians at the  
7       United Nations or its specialized agencies, including  
8       under section 414 of the Foreign Relations Author-  
9       ization Act, Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 (Public  
10      Law 101–246) and section 410 of Foreign Relations  
11      Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995  
12      (Public Law 103–236);

13              (2) affirms that the United States shall not  
14      make available any United States Government offi-  
15      cial to serve in any capacity as a representative to  
16      any United Nations specialized agency or affiliated  
17      organization which has granted full membership as  
18      a state to any organization or group that does not

1 have the internationally recognized attributes of  
2 statehood;

3 (3) opposes the recognition of a Palestinian  
4 state by any United Nations entity, or any upgrade,  
5 including full membership or the accession to any  
6 treaty or agreement, in the status of the Palestin-  
7 ians at the United Nations, the Palestine Liberation  
8 Organization, the Palestinian Authority, or any  
9 other Palestinian administrative organization or gov-  
10 erning entity, at any United Nations entity, prior to  
11 the achievement of a final peace agreement nego-  
12 tiated between and agreed to by Israel and the Pal-  
13 estinians; and

14 (4) reiterates its support for a negotiated settle-  
15 ment leading to a sustainable two-state solution with  
16 the democratic, Jewish state of Israel and a demili-  
17 tarized, democratic Palestinian state living side-by-  
18 side in peace and security.
