

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1163, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. FROST OF FLORIDA

Page 16, after line 5, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act shall not take effect until the Secretary of
3 Labor certifies that no amendment made by this Act
4 would result in an individual being required to repay to
5 a State agency amounts of Federal Pandemic Unemploy-
6 ment Compensation or Mixed Earner Unemployment
7 Compensation received under sections 2102, 2104, or
8 2107 of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C. 9021, 9023, or 9025)
9 to which they were not entitled if—

10 (1) the State agency determines that the pay-
11 ment of such pandemic unemployment compensation
12 was without fault on the part of any such individual;
13 and

14 (2) such individual was affected by a natural
15 disaster (including a hurricane, wildfire, tornado,
16 drought, flooding, earthquake, volcano, or tsunami)
17 for which a major disaster or emergency was de-
18 clared by the President in 2020 or 2021, or is cur-

- 1 rently being affected by a natural disaster for which
- 2 the President has made such a declaration.
