

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10**  
**OFFERED BY MR. FROST OF FLORIDA**

At the appropriate place in subtitle J of title V, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . STUDY AND REPORT ON MILITARY FIREARMS**  
2 **PROTOCOLS.**

3 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Not later than 2 years  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
5 of Defense shall submit to Congress a report—

6 (1) containing the results of the study described  
7 in subsection (b); and

8 (2) evaluating the protocols examined in the  
9 course of such study in comparison to civilian fire-  
10 arms protocols and standards.

11 (b) **STUDY.**—The study described in this section is  
12 an examination of the following:

13 (1) Standard firearm safety protocols promul-  
14 gated in publications such as military regulations,  
15 field manuals, and technical manuals used by mem-  
16 bers of the Armed Forces.

17 (2) The manner and extent to which user safety  
18 and proportional force considerations influence the

1 procedures and practices of units of the Armed  
2 Forces, including with respect to—

3 (A) the acquisition of service rifles and  
4 sidearms;

5 (B) storage and access protocols for fire-  
6 arms;

7 (C) storage and access protocols for am-  
8 munition; and

9 (D) the acquisition of ammunition.

10 (3) Firearms qualification and requalification  
11 standards as well as the process to obtain such sta-  
12 tus for service rifles and sidearms, including time  
13 taken for training and the frequency of requalifica-  
14 tion.

15 (4) Outcomes such as mass shootings, negligent  
16 discharges, or suicide by firearm involving members  
17 of the Armed Forces, as compared to instances of  
18 such outcomes—

19 (A) involving civilians or servicemembers  
20 with personally-owned weapons; and

21 (B) involving service rifles or sidearms.
