

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2255, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. FROST OF FLORIDA**

Page 3, insert after line 14 the following:

1 (1) the Federal agency involved obtains from
2 the officer, in writing, the agreement of the officer
3 to not authorize any other person to use or control
4 the firearm without the written approval of the Fed-
5 eral agency;

Page 3, line 15, strike “(1)” and insert “(2)”.

Page 3, line 18, strike “(2)” and insert “(3)”.

Page 3, after line 23, insert the following:

6 (d) LIABILITY OF THE UNITED STATES FOR CIVIL
7 RIGHTS DEPRIVATIONS RESULTING FROM USE OF PUR-
8 CHASED RETIRED FIREARMS.—Section 1979 of the Re-
9 vised Statutes (42 U.S.C. 1983) is amended—

10 (1) by inserting “of the United States” or be-
11 fore “of any State”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following: “The
13 remedies provided by this section with respect to
14 conduct under color of any statute, ordinance, regu-
15 lation, custom, or usage of the United States shall

1 be available only in the case that the deprivation re-
2 sults from the use of a firearm sold pursuant to the
3 Federal Law Enforcement Officer Service Weapon
4 Purchase Act of 2025, by the purchaser or any other
5 individual who lawfully accesses the firearm while
6 owned by the purchaser, and for purposes of this
7 section, the sale is deemed to be a grant of authority
8 by the seller to use the firearm, and the use is
9 deemed to be conduct under color of such Act.”.

Page 3, line 24, strike “(d)” and insert “(e)”.
