## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–8

## OFFERED BY MR. FROST OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle H of title VIII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 INSPECTOR GENERAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
2	DEFENSE ANNUAL REPORT ON OVERSIGHT
3	OF FRAUD, WASTE, AND ABUSE.
4	(a) Report Required.—The Inspector General of
5	the Department of Defense shall submit to Congress and
6	the Comptroller General of the United States a detailed
7	annual report containing—
8	(1) the total amount and dollar value of over-
9	sight investigations into fraud waste and abuse con-
10	ducted by the Department of Defense Office of In-
11	spector General, and the total amount and dollar
12	value of oversight investigations into fraud, waste,
13	and abuse conducted by the Offices of Inspector
14	General of each of the military departments;
15	(2) statistical tables showing—
16	(A) the total number and dollar value of
17	oversight investigations completed and pending,

1	set forth separately by type of oversight inves-
2	tigation;
3	(B) the priority given to each type of over-
4	sight investigation;
5	(C) the length of time taken for each type
6	of oversight investigation, both from the date of
7	receipt of a qualified incurred cost submission
8	and from the date the oversight investigation
9	begins;
10	(D) the aggregate cost of performing over-
11	sight investigations, set forth separately by type
12	of oversight investigation; and
13	(E) the total number and dollar value of
14	oversight investigations that are pending for a
15	period longer than one year as of the end of the
16	fiscal year covered by the report, and the fiscal
17	year in which the qualified submission was re-
18	ceived, set forth separately by type of oversight
19	investigation;
20	(3) a summary of any recommendations of ac-
21	tions or resources needed to improve the oversight
22	investigation process; and
23	(4) any other matters the Inspector General
24	considers appropriate.

- 1 (b) Public Availability.—Each report submitted
- 2 under subsection (a) shall be made publicly available.
- 3 (c) Sunset.—This section shall cease to have any
- 4 force or effect after the end of the 4-year period beginning
- 5 on the date of enactment of this Act.
