

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–33

OFFERED BY MS. PATRONIS OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle B of title XXVIII, insert the following new section:

**SEC. __. INAPPLICABILITY OF NATIONAL HISTORIC
PRESERVATION ACT TO CERTAIN MILITARY HOUSING.**

(a) In general.—Section 307104 of title 54, United States Code is amended—

(1) in the heading—

(A) by striking “or”; and

(B) by striking “Capitol” and inserting “Capitol, and certain military housing”;

(2) in the section—

(A) by inserting “—” after “Nothing in the division applies to”;

(B) by inserting “(a)” before “the White House and its grounds, the Supreme Court building and its grounds”;

(C) by striking “or” before “the United States Capitol and its related buildings and grounds” and inserting “, and” after “grounds”;

(D) by inserting before the period at the end the following new subsection:

“(b) any building or structure on an installation of the Armed Forces that is or has ever been used as military unaccompanied housing or military family housing, with the exception of any such building or structure listed on the National Register of Historic Places as of January 20, 2025, or any such building or structure the Secretary of Defense specifically exempts from this provision subject to the following limitations—”

“(1) If the Secretary of Defense elects to make any discretionary exemptions as described in subsection (b), the total number of

1 discretionary exemptions may not exceed one-one-tenth of one
2 percent of the total number of buildings or structures on installations
3 of the Armed Forces that are or ever have been used as military
4 unaccompanied housing or military family housing; and”

5 “(2) Any buildings or structures specifically exempted by the
6 Secretary of Defense pursuant to subsection (b)(1) shall be managed
7 in accordance with this division unless or until the Secretary of
8 Defense elects to remove the discretionary exemption granted to any
9 such building or structure.”.
