

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4820, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. BARR OF KENTUCKY

Page 122, line 3, strike the semicolon at the end and insert the following: “: Provided further; that with respect to the amounts made available for the Continuum of Care program under this paragraph, the Secretary may not, prohibit, limit, or restrict the award or amount of grants made with such amounts to or for eligible entities, project sponsors, or recipients— that require the provision of supportive services, such as counseling, job training, or addiction treatment, for individuals served by a program, project, or activity assisted with such amounts; that require, as a condition for occupancy in a project, or assistance from a program, project, or activity, assisted with such amounts that individuals meet certain prerequisites, such as sobriety or lack of drug use; or that are faith-based organizations: Provided further; that of the amounts made available for the Continuum of Care program under this paragraph, not less than 30 percent of such amounts shall be provided to eligible entities, project sponsors, and recipients that provide or offer access to wraparound services;”
