(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404 of the Justice for 3 4 United States Victims of State Sponsored Terrorism Act 5 (34 U.S.C. 20144(e)(2)(B)) is amended— 6 (1) in subsection (e)(2)(B), by adding at the 7 end the following: "(vi) EXCEPTION FOR THE HAVLISH 8 9 SETTLING JUDGMENT CREDITORS.— 10 "(I) IN GENERAL.—This sub-11 section does not apply with respect 12 to---13 "(aa) a Havlish Settling 14 Judgment Creditor who pre-15 viously elected to participate in 16 the Fund in accordance with 17 clause (iii) or who submitted a 2

2	accordance with clause (iv); or
3	"(bb) the assets, or the net
4	proceeds of the sale of properties

7	"(II) Release of funds held

7	"(A) has an eligible claim under subsection
8	(c) that arose out of the September 11, 2001,
9	terrorist attacks against the United States; and
10	"(B) is a Settling Judgment Creditor iden-
11	tified in the Order dated April 16, 2014, in the
12	proceedings captioned In re 650 Fifth Avenue
13	and Related Properties, No. 08–CV–10934
14	(S.D.N.Y.).".

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
