AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3838, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MS. TENNEY OF NEW YORK

At the appropriate place in subtitle C of title XII, insert the following:

SEC. . MANDATORY NOTIFICATION WITH RESPECT TO IRANIAN SANCTIONS.

- (a) SENSE OF THE CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the Congress that the United States must maintain robust sanctions on the Islamic Republic of Iran to hinder its terrorism and deter its pursuit, development, or acquisition of a nuclear weapon.
- (b) MANDATORY NOTIFICATION.—The President shall notify Congress not later than 15 days after any action by the President to ease sanctions on Iran, without regard to whether such actions is in the context of negotiations with Iran or a unilateral determination by the United States.
- (c) NOTIFICATION DESCRIBED.—Each notification required by subsection (b) shall contain the following:
 - (1) Detailed information regarding the action to be taken.
 - (2) An estimate of the financial benefit to the Islamic Republic of Iran as a result of such action.
 - (3) A detailed accounting of how such financial relief will not be redirected to terrorism, conventional weapons development, nuclear weapons development, nuclear research, or the oppression of the Iranian people.
- (d) FORM.—The notification required by subsection (b) shall be transmitted in an unclassified manner and may contain a classified annex.
