At the end of subtitle D of title VIII, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 CRITICAL AND RARE EARTH MINERAL SUPPLY
2	CHAIN STUDY.
3	(a) In General.—Not later than one year after the
4	date of the enactment of this Act, the Deputy Assistant
5	Secretary of Defense for Industrial Base Resilience, in co-
6	ordination with the Secretary of the Interior, Secretary of
7	Energy, and the Director of the United States Geological
8	Survey, shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services
9	and Natural Resources of the House of Representatives
10	a report on the feasibility of reshoring domestic critical
11	and rare earth mineral mining and production.
12	(b) Contents.—The report required under sub-
13	section (a) shall include—
14	(1) an identification of the strategic and critical
15	materials used by the Department of Defense;
16	(2) an assessment of the reliability of the do-
17	mestic supply chains for critical and rare earth min-
18	erals and the reliance for such critical and rare
19	earth minerals on sources that are located in Peo-

1	ple's Republic of China or related to or subject to
2	the control of People's Republic of China or the Chi-
3	nese Communist Party;
4	(3) an identification of the domestic and inter-
5	national sources for the strategic and critical mate-
6	rials identified under paragraph (1);
7	(4) an identification of domestic locations with
8	existing commercial manufacturing interest that are
9	verified as containing large supplies of strategic and
10	critical materials identified under paragraph (1);
11	(5) a strategy to reshore critical and rare earth
12	mineral production to the United States; and
13	(6) a plan to implement the strategy required
14	by paragraph (5), including a timeline for such im-
15	plementation.
16	(c) Strategic and Critical Materials De-
17	FINED.—In this section, the term "strategic and critical
18	materials" has the meaning given such term in section 12
19	of the Strategic and Critical Materials Stock Piling Act
20	(50 U.S.C. 98h-3).
