At the end of title I, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 1 ANNUAL REPORT ON DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS
2	RELATING TO SECTION 702.
3	(a) Annual Report.—Not later than March 1 of
4	each year, the Director of National Intelligence, in coordi-
5	nation with the Attorney General and the Director of the
6	National Security Agency, shall submit to the Committee
7	on the Judiciary and the Permanent Select Committee on
8	Intelligence of the House of Representatives and the Com-
9	mittee on the Judiciary and the Select Committee on In-
10	telligence of the Senate a report on disciplinary actions
11	taken against an employee of the United States Govern-
12	ment relating to mishandling information acquired under
13	section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act
14	of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1881a) in violation of such section,
15	an order of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court,
16	or regulations, guidance, or administrative requirements
17	issued pursuant to such section.

1	(b) Matters Included.—Each report under sub-
2	section (a) shall include, with respect to the year covered
3	by the report, the following:
4	(1) The total number of violations described in
5	subsection (a) that occurred.
6	(2) A description of each specific violation de-
7	scribed in subsection (a) that occurred.
8	(3) With respect to each such violation—
9	(A) whether any corresponding disciplinary
10	action was taken and the result of that discipli-
11	nary action, including each termination of an
12	employee by reason of such violation;
13	(C) whether such violation resulted in a
14	criminal charge, and the result of that criminal
15	charge; and
16	(D) if no corresponding disciplinary action
17	was taken, the reasons no such action was
18	taken.
19	(c) Initial Report.—The first report submitted
20	under subsection (a) shall cover, in addition to the year
21	covered by the report, violations described in subsection
22	(a) that occurred before such year.
