In subtitle C of title V, add at the end the following:

1	SEC. 5 PROHIBITION ON INVOLUNTARILY ASSIGNING
2	FEMALE OFFICERS A COMBAT ARMS SPE-

4	(a) Prohibitions.—The Secretary of the Army may
5	not—
6	(1) require female officer candidates to list a
7	combat arms branch on their branch preference list
8	to commission into the Army;
9	(2) assign female officer candidates to a combat
10	arms branch that is not listed as an option on their
11	application;
12	(3) require female officer candidates to train or
13	become qualified in a combat arms Military Occupa-
14	tional Specialty; or
15	(4) assign female officer candidates to a combat
16	arms unit involuntarily.
17	(b) CERTIFICATIONS.—Not later than one year after
18	the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
19	after, the Secretary of the Army shall submit to the Com-

- 2 of Representatives a report certifying, for each female offi-
- 3 cer newly assigned to a combat arms branch, that—
- 4 (1) the female officer volunteered for assign-
- 5 ment to that branch; and
- 6 (2) the female officer satisfied all physical re-
- 7 quirements for service in that branch.
- 8 (c) Definitions.—In this section, the term "combat
- 9 arms branch" includes Air Defense, Armor, Infantry,
- 10 Field Artillery, Corps of Engineers, and Aviation.
