At the end of title XVIII add the following:

1	SEC. 1859. REPORT ON NATIONAL SECURITY THREATS OF
2	FOREIGN-OWNED AGRICULTURAL LAND

4	(a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than one year
5	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
6	of Defense, in consultation with the Secretary of Agri-
7	culture, shall submit to Congress a report on foreign-
8	owned agricultural land located within 50 miles of a
9	United States military installation.
10	(b) Elements.—The report required under sub-
11	section (a) shall include—
12	(1) a list of each foreign person that owns agri-
13	cultural land located within 50 miles of a United
14	States military installation;
15	(2) in the case of an individual described in
16	paragraph (1), the citizenship of such individual;
17	(3) in the case of a foreign person described in
18	paragraph (1) that is not an individual or govern-
10	ment

1	(A) the principal place of business of such
2	person; and
3	(B) the country in which each such foreign
4	person is created or organized;
5	(4) the nature of each legal entity holding inter-
6	est in such agricultural land and the type of interest;
7	(5) the legal description and acreage of such
8	agricultural land; and
9	(6) an assessment of any threat that foreign
10	ownership of such agricultural land may have on
11	United States military readiness, food supply, and
12	national security.
13	(c) AGRICULTURAL LAND DEFINED.—In this section,
14	the term "agricultural land" includes—
15	(1) crop land, pasture land, wetlands, and
16	marshlands;
17	(2) land enrolled in a Federal, State, or local
18	agricultural conservation program; and
19	(3) land used for animal confinement, con-
20	centrated animal feeding operations, livestock pro-
21	duction, timber production, or forestry.
