

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**OFFERED BY MS. GABBARD OF HAWAII**

At the end of subtitle D of title XVI, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 1651. PROHIBITION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR**  
**2 INTERMEDIATE-RANGE MISSILES.**

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—None of the funds authorized to  
4 be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made available  
5 for the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2020 may  
6 be used for the testing and evaluation, procurement, or  
7 fielding of offensive land-based ballistic and cruise missiles  
8 with ranges between 500 and 5,500 kilometers or associ-  
9 ated launchers, regardless of whether such missiles have  
10 nuclear or conventional warheads.

11 (b) CALCULATION OF RANGES.—For purposes of  
12 subsection (a)—

13 (1) the range capability of a ground-launched  
14 ballistic missile shall be considered to be the max-  
15 imum range to which the missile has been tested;  
16 and

17 (2) the range of a ground-launched cruise mis-  
18 sile is the maximum distance which can be covered

1 by the missile in its standard design mode flying  
2 until fuel exhaustion, determined by projecting its  
3 flight path onto the earth's sphere from the point of  
4 launch to the point of impact.

5 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) The term “ballistic missile” means a missile  
7 that has a ballistic trajectory over most of its flight  
8 path.

9 (2) The term “cruise missile” means an un-  
10 manned, self-propelled vehicle that sustains flight  
11 through the use of aerodynamic lift over most of its  
12 flight path.
