Page 691, insert after line 10 the following:

1 **SEC. 1051. ACCESS TO SCI BY HOUSE AND SENATE EMPLOY-**
2 **EES WITH CLEARANCES ISSUED BY DEPART-**
3 **MENT OF DEFENSE.**

4 (a) ACCESS TO SCI.—If the Department of Defense
5 Central Adjudication Facility or a successor office deter-
6 mines that an individual who is serving as an employee
7 of the House of Representatives or an employee of the
8 Senate is eligible for access to Sensitive Compartmented
9 Information (SCI)—

10 (1) in the case of an employee of the House of
11 Representatives, the Office of House Security shall
12 take such actions as may be necessary to provide the
13 individual with access to SCI in facilities of the
14 House; and

15 (2) in the case of an employee of the Senate,
16 the Office of Senate Security shall take such actions
17 as may be necessary to provide the individual with
18 access to SCI in facilities of the Senate.

1 (b) INCLUSION OF FELLOWS AND DETAILEES.—In
2 this section, the term “employee” includes an individual
3 serving in an office of the House of Representatives or
4 an office of the Senate as a fellow or detailee from another
5 office of the government.

6 (c) EXERCISE OF RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.—This
7 section is enacted by Congress—

8 (1) as an exercise of the rulemaking power of
9 the House of Representatives and Senate, and as
10 such it is deemed a part of the rules of the House
11 of Representatives and Senate, and it supersedes
12 other rules only to the extent that it is inconsistent
13 with such rules; and

14 (2) with full recognition of the constitutional
15 right of either house of Congress to change the rules
16 (so far as relating to the procedure of that house)
17 at any time, in the same manner, and to the same
18 extent as in the case of any other rule of that house.
