Add at the end of subtitle C of title V the following new section:

1	SEC. 5 CONDITIONAL AUTHORIZATION OF AN OFFICER
2	OR MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES, SERV-
3	ING ON ACTIVE DUTY, TO SEEK CIVIL OFFICE.
4	(a) Authorization.—Section 973 of title 10, United
5	States Code, is amended—
6	(1) in subsection (b)—
7	(A) in paragraphs (1) through (5), by
8	striking "officer" each place it appears and in-
9	serting "officer or member";
10	(B) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
11	paragraph (7); and
12	(C) by inserting after paragraph (5) the
13	following new paragraph (6):
14	"(6) The Secretary concerned may permit an officer
15	or member serving on active duty to seek civil office (in-
16	cluding participating in political campaign activities) if—

1	"(A) such officer or member is eligible for
2	preseparation counseling under section 1142 of this
3	title;
4	"(B) such officer or member is on terminal
5	leave;
6	"(C) the term of such civil office begins after
7	the anticipated date of the discharge or release from
8	active duty of the officer or member; and
9	"(D) in the course of seeking civil office, the of-
10	ficer or member does not use any Federal property
11	or refer to the rank or grade of such officer or mem-
12	ber."; and
13	(2) in subsection (c), by striking "officer" and
14	inserting "officer or member".
15	(b) Clerical Amendment.—Such section is amend-
16	ed in the heading by striking "officers" and inserting
17	"members".
