At the end of subtitle J of title V, insert the following:

6	(a) Reinstatement.—
7	(1) Election.—At the election of a covered in-
8	dividual, the Secretary concerned shall reinstate the
9	covered individual as a member of the Armed Force
10	concerned, in the same rank and grade the covered
11	individual held at the time of separation from such
12	Armed Force.
13	(2) Deadlines.—A covered individual may
14	make an election under this subsection during the
15	period of 90 days following the date of the enact-
16	ment of this Act. The Secretary concerned shall re-
17	instate a covered individual who makes such an elec-
18	tion not later than 90 days after such election.

1	(b) Back Pay; Promotion; Hardship Bonus.—
2	(1) Back pay.—A covered individual who
3	makes an election under subsection (a) shall be enti-
4	tled to back pay for the period between the separa-
5	tion of the covered individual from the Armed
6	Forces and the date of the enactment of this Act.
7	(2) Promotion.—If, during the period de-
8	scribed in paragraph (1), a covered individual, who
9	makes an election under subsection (a), did not re-
10	ceive a promotion solely because such individual was
11	a covered individual—
12	(A) the Secretary concerned shall grant
13	such promotion; and
14	(B) the amount of such back pay under
15	such paragraph shall be determined based on
16	the grade of the covered individual pursuant to
17	such promotion.
18	(3) Hardship bonus.—A covered individual
19	who makes an election under subsection (a) shall be
20	entitled to a hardship bonus in the amount of
21	\$15,000.
22	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
23	(1) The term "covered individual" means an in-
24	dividual who was involuntarily separated from an
25	Armed Force solely on the basis of the refusal of

such individual to receive a vaccination against COVID-19.

(2) The term "Secretary concerned" has the meaning given such term in section 101 of title 10, United States Code.
