At the end of the bill, insert the following:

10	(b) ITEMS DESCRIBED.—The items referred to in
11	subsection (a) are armor, artillery, automatic weapons am-
12	munition, missiles, and other munitions that—
13	(1) are obsolete or surplus items;
14	(2) are in the inventory of the Department of
15	Defense;
16	(3) are intended for use as reserve stocks for
17	Taiwan; and
18	(4) are located in a stockpile in Taiwan.

- 1 (c) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 2 30 days before making a transfer under the authority of 3 this section, the President shall transmit a notification of 4 the proposed transfer to the Committee on Foreign Affairs
- 5 and the Committee on Armed Services of the House of
- 6 Representatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations
- 7 and the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate. The
- 8 notification shall identify the items to be transferred and
- 9 the concessions to be received.
