

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle B of title III, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3__ . AUTHORITY TO FURNISH ELECTRIC VEHICLE**
2 **CHARGING STATIONS AT DEFENSE COM-**
3 **MISSARY AND EXCHANGE STORES.**

4 Subchapter I of chapter 147 of title 10, United States
5 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
6 section:

7 **“§ 2486. Authority to furnish electric vehicle charging**
8 **stations at commissary and exchanges**
9 **stores**

10 “(a) **AUTHORITY.**—The Secretary of Defense may
11 furnish electric vehicle charging stations at a commissary
12 or exchange store (including in a parking lot thereof) for
13 commercial use by individuals authorized to access such
14 facilities.

15 “(b) **RATES AND PROCEDURES.**—If the Secretary of
16 Defense furnishes an electric vehicle charging station pur-
17 suant to subsection (a)—

1 “(1) the Secretary shall establish rates and pro-
2 cedures that the Secretary determines appropriate
3 for the purchase of electric power from such charg-
4 ing station; and

5 “(2) such charging station may be installed and
6 operated by a contractor of the Department of De-
7 fense.

8 “(c) INTEROPERABILITY.—Any electric vehicle charg-
9 ing station furnished under this section shall use a charg-
10 ing connector type (or other means to transmit electricity
11 to the vehicle) that—

12 “(1) meets applicable industry-accepted stand-
13 ards for interoperability and safety; and

14 “(2) is compatible with—

15 “(A) commercially available electric vehi-
16 cles; and

17 “(B) covered nontactical vehicles (as de-
18 fined in section 2922g(g) of this title) for which
19 electric charging is required.”.
