

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-

OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle G of title X, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10__ . TRANSFER OF EXCESS AIRCRAFT TO OTHER**
2 **DEPARTMENTS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERN-**
3 **MENT.**

4 Section 1091 of the National Defense Authorization
5 Act for Fiscal Year 2013 (Public Law 112-239; 10 U.S.C.
6 2576 note) is amended—

7 (1) by striking subsection (c);

8 (2) in subsection (d)—

9 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “up to
10 seven”; and

11 (B) by amending paragraph (2) to read as
12 follows:

13 “(2) EXPIRATION OF RIGHT OF REFUSAL.—A
14 right of refusal afforded the Secretary of Agriculture
15 or the Secretary of Homeland Security under para-
16 graph (1) with regards to an aircraft shall expire
17 upon official notice of such Secretary to the Sec-

1 retary of Defense that such Secretary declines such
2 aircraft.”;

3 (3) in subsection (e)—

4 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “,
5 search and rescue, or emergency operations per-
6 taining to wildfires” after “purposes”; and

7 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “,
8 search and rescue, emergency operations per-
9 taining to wildfires,” after “efforts”;

10 (4) by striking subsection (f); and

11 (5) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12 section:

13 “(h) REPORTING.—Not later than November 1,
14 2022, and annually thereafter, the Secretary of Defense
15 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the
16 Senate and House of Representatives a report on aircraft
17 transferred, during the fiscal year preceding the date of
18 such report to—

19 “(1) the Secretary of Agriculture or the Sec-
20 retary of Homeland Security under this section;

21 “(2) the chief executive officer of a State under
22 section 112 of the National Defense Authorization
23 Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (Public Law 112–81); or

24 “(3) the Secretary of the Air Force or the Sec-
25 retary of Agriculture under section 1098 of the Na-

1 tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
2 2014 (Public Law 113–66; 127 Stat. 881).”.
