

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–8**  
**OFFERED BY MR. GARBARINO OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 17\_\_\_\_. 9/11 RESPONDER AND SURVIVOR HEALTH**  
**2 FUNDING CORRECTIONS.**

**3 (a) IN GENERAL.**—Section 3351(a)(2)(A) of the  
**4 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300mm–**  
**5 61(a)(2)(A)) is amended—**

**6 (1) in clause (x), by striking “; and” and insert-**  
**7 ing a semicolon;**

**8 (2) by redesignating clause (xi) as clause (xii);**  
**9 and**

**10 (3) by inserting after clause (x), the following:**

**11 “(xi) for each of fiscal years 2026**  
**12 through 2040—**

**13 “(I) the amount determined**  
**14 under this subparagraph for the pre-**  
**15 vious fiscal year multiplied by 1.05;**  
**16 multiplied by**

**17 “(II) the ratio of—**

1 “(aa) the total number of  
2 individuals enrolled in the WTC  
3 Program on July 1 of such pre-  
4 vious fiscal year; to

5 “(bb) the total number of  
6 individuals so enrolled on July 1  
7 of the fiscal year prior to such  
8 previous fiscal year; and”.

9 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after  
11 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of  
12 Health and Human Services (referred to in this sub-  
13 section as the “Secretary”) shall conduct an assess-  
14 ment of anticipated budget authority and outlays of  
15 the World Trade Center Health Program (referred  
16 to in this subsection as the “Program”) through the  
17 duration of the Program and submit a report sum-  
18 marizing such assessment to—

19 (A) the Speaker and minority leader of the  
20 House of Representatives;

21 (B) the majority and minority leaders of  
22 the Senate;

23 (C) the Committee on Health, Education,  
24 Labor, and Pensions and Committee on the  
25 Budget of the Senate; and

1 (D) the Committee on Energy and Com-  
2 merce and the Committee on the Budget of the  
3 House of Representatives.

4 (2) INCLUSIONS.—The report required under  
5 paragraph (1) shall include—

6 (A) a projection of Program budgetary  
7 needs on a per-fiscal year basis through fiscal  
8 year 2090;

9 (B) a review of Program modeling for each  
10 of fiscal years 2017 through the fiscal year  
11 prior to the fiscal year in which the report is  
12 issued to assess how anticipated budgetary  
13 needs compared to actual expenditures;

14 (C) an assessment of the projected budget  
15 authority and expenditures of the Program  
16 through fiscal year 2090 by comparing—

17 (i) such projected authority and ex-  
18 penditures resulting from application of  
19 section 3351(a)(2)(A) of the Public Health  
20 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300mm–  
21 61(a)(2)(A)), as amended by subsection  
22 (a); and

23 (ii) such projected authority and ex-  
24 penditures that would result if such section  
25 were amended so that the formula under

1 clause (xi) of such section, as amended by  
2 subsection (a), were to be extended  
3 through fiscal year 2090; and

4 (D) any recommendations of the Secretary  
5 to make changes to the formula under such sec-  
6 tion 3351(a)(2)(A), as so amended, to fully off-  
7 set anticipated Program expenditures through  
8 fiscal year 2090.

9 (c) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—Title XXXIII of the  
10 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300mm et seq.) is  
11 amended—

12 (1) in section 3352(d) (42 U.S.C. 300mm–  
13 62(d)), by striking “Any amounts” and inserting  
14 “Any unobligated amounts”;

15 (2) in section 3353(d) (42 U.S.C. 300mm–  
16 63(d)), by striking “Any amounts” and inserting  
17 “Any unobligated amounts”; and

18 (3) in section 3354(d) (42 U.S.C. 300mm–  
19 64(d)), by striking “Any amounts” and inserting  
20 “Any unobligated amounts”.
