TITLE IV—FIRE INFORMATION AND REACTION ENHANCE MENT ACT

4 SEC. 401. SHORT TITLE.

5 This title may be cited as the "Fire Information and6 Reaction Enhancement Act" or the "FIRE Act".

7 SEC. 402. WILDFIRE FORECASTING AND DETECTION.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Na-9 tional Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, in col-10 laboration with the United States weather industry and 11 such academic entities as the Administrator considers ap-12 propriate, shall establish and maintain a program within 13 such Administration to improve wildfire forecasting and 14 detection.

(b) GOALS.—The goals of the program maintained
under subsection (a) shall be to develop and extend accurate wildfire forecasts and warnings in order to reduce loss

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of life, injury, property, and damage to the economy, with 1 2 a focus on-3 (1) improving the prediction of intensification 4 and spread of wildfires; (2) improving the forecast and communication 5 6 of smoke dispersion from wildfires; 7 (3) improving information dissemination and 8 risk communication to create more effective watch 9 and warning products; and 10 (4) improving the early detection of wildfires to 11 contain their growth and mitigate damages. 12 (c) ELEMENTS.—In order to meet the goals outlined in subsection (b), the Administrator is authorized to con-13 duct development, testing, and deployment activities re-14 15 lated to— 16 (1) advanced satellite detection products;

17 (2) grid-based assessments and outlooks of fuel 18 moisture and danger levels;

19 (3) coupled atmosphere and fire modeling sys-20 tems;

21 (4) systems to link climate predictions to 22 achievable land management decisions; and

23 (5) improved spatial and temporal resolution 24 observations in high latitudes.

25 (d) CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZATION.— 3

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days 2 after the enactment of this Act, the Assistant Ad-3 ministrator for the Office of Oceanic and Atmos-4 pheric Research shall establish a program to create 5 one or more weather research testbeds, in partner-6 ship with industry and academic partners, to develop 7 improved detection of and forecast capabilities for 8 wildfire events and their impacts.

9 (2) RESOURCES.—In carrying out the program 10 under paragraph (1), the Assistant Administrator 11 may not take resources for such testbeds from the 12 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration 13 cooperative institutes in existence as of the date of 14 enactment of this Act.

(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
authorized to be appropriated \$15,000,000 for fiscal year
2023 to carry out the program under subsection (d).

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
