Page 1508, after line 13, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10109. MOTOR VEHICLE PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLIST**  
2 **PROTECTION.**

3 (a) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 2 years after the  
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-  
5 tation, acting through the Administrator of the National  
6 Highway Traffic Safety Administration, shall issue a final  
7 rule that—

8 (1) establishes standards for the hood and  
9 bumper areas of motor vehicles, including passenger  
10 cars, multipurpose passenger vehicles, trucks, and  
11 buses with a gross vehicle weight rating of 4,536  
12 kilograms (10,000 pounds) or less, in order to re-  
13 duce the number of injuries and fatalities suffered  
14 by vulnerable road users, including pedestrians and  
15 cyclists, who are struck by such vehicles; and

16 (2) considers the protection of vulnerable pedes-  
17 trian and cycling populations, including children and  
18 older adults, and people with disabilities.

1           (b) COMPLIANCE.—The rule issued pursuant to sub-  
2 section (a) shall require full compliance with minimum  
3 performance standards established by the Secretary not  
4 later than 2 years after the date on which the final rule  
5 is issued.
