Page 634, beginning line 24, strike paragraph (1)
and insert the following:

1 (1)) \$195,000,000 for the State Homeland Se-
2 curity Grant Program under section 2004 of the
3 Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 605), of
4 which \$15,000,000 shall be for Tribal Homeland Se-
5 curity Grants under section 2005 of the Homeland
6 Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 606), and
7 \$180,000,000 shall be for organizations (as de-
8 scribed under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Rev-
9 enue Code of 1986 and exempt from tax under sec-
10 tion 501(a) of such code) determined by the Sec-
11 retary of Homeland Security to be at high risk of a
12 terrorist attack: *Provided*, That notwithstanding
13 subsection (c)(4) of such section 2004, for fiscal
14 year 2021, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico shall
15 make available to local and tribal governments
16 amounts provided to the Commonwealth of Puerto
17 Rico under this paragraph in accordance with sub-
18 section (c)(1) of such section 2004.

Page 635, beginning line 18, strike paragraph (2)
and insert the following:

1 (2) \$180,000,000 for the Urban Area Security
2 Initiative under section 2003 of the Homeland Secu-
3 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 604), which shall be for
4 organizations (as described under section 501(c)(3)
5 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt
6 from tax under section 501(a) of such code) deter-
7 mined by the Secretary of Homeland Security to be
8 at high risk of a terrorist attack.
