

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 27

OFFERED BY MS. GILLEN OF NEW YORK

Page 22, line 19, strike “and” at the end.

Page 22, line 23, strike the period at the end and
insert a semicolon.

Page 22, after line 23, add the following:

1 (3) in subparagraph (A), in the matter fol-
2 lowing clause (viii), by striking “20 years or more
3 than life” and inserting “(or in the case of a person
4 who is a member of transnational criminal organiza-
5 tion (as defined in part 590 of title 31, Code of Fed-
6 eral Regulations (or successor regulations)) who vio-
7 lates subsection (a) with respect to a fentanyl-re-
8 lated substance, if death results from the use of such
9 substance, not less than 25 years and if serious bod-
10 ily injury results from the use of such substance, not
11 more than life)”; and

12 (4) in subparagraph (B), in the matter fol-
13 lowing clause (viii), by striking “20 years or more
14 than life” and inserting “(or in the case of a person
15 who is a member of transnational criminal organiza-
16 tion (as defined in part 590 of title 31, Code of Fed-

1 eral Regulations (or successor regulations)) who vio-
2 lates subsection (a) with respect to a fentanyl-re-
3 lated substance, if death results from the use of such
4 substance, not less than 25 years and if serious bod-
5 ily injury results from the use of such substance, not
6 more than life)”.

Page 23, line 7, strike “and” at the end.

Page 23, line 11, strike the period at the end and
inserting a semicolon.

Page 23, after line 11, add the following:

7 (3) in paragraph (1), in the matter following
8 subparagraph (H), by striking “20 years and not
9 more than life” and inserting “(or in the case of a
10 person who is a member of transnational criminal
11 organization (as defined in part 590 of title 31,
12 Code of Federal Regulations (or successor regula-
13 tions)) who violates subsection (a) with respect to a
14 fentanyl-related substance, if death results from the
15 use of such substance, not less than 25 years and
16 if serious bodily injury results from the use of such
17 substance, not more than life)”; and
18 (4) in paragraph (2), in the matter following
19 subparagraph (H), by striking “twenty years and
20 not more than life” and inserting “(or in the case

1 of a person who is a member of transnational crimi-
2 nal organization (as defined in part 590 of title 31,
3 Code of Federal Regulations (or successor regula-
4 tions)) who violates subsection (a) with respect to a
5 fentanyl-related substance, if death results from the
6 use of such substance, not less than 25 years and
7 if serious bodily injury results from the use of such
8 substance, not more than life)''.
