

**AMENDMENT TO RULES**  
**COMMITTEE PRINT 119–8**  
**OFFERED BY MS. GILLEN OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle G of title V, add the following:

1   **SEC. 567. IMPROVEMENT OF TRANSITION OF AIR TRAFFIC**  
2                   **CONTROLLERS IN THE ARMED FORCES TO**  
3                   **THE CIVILIAN WORKFORCE IN AIR TRAFFIC**  
4                   **CONTROL OCCUPATIONS.**

5       (a) **RECOMMENDATIONS REQUIRED.**—Within 180  
6 days of passage, the Secretary of Defense, in consultation  
7 with each of the States (through the Defense-State Liai-  
8 son Office of the Department of Defense), the Secretary  
9 of Veterans Affairs, the Secretary of Transportation, and  
10 the Secretary of Labor, shall develop recommendations to  
11 improve the transition of military air traffic controllers  
12 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary into the civilian  
13 workforce in air traffic control occupations.

14       (b) **CONSIDERATIONS.**—In carrying out subsection  
15 (a), the Secretary shall identify any barriers—

16               (1) to improving the ability of the Secretary to  
17 determine and communicate how the military cre-  
18 dentials and experience of a controller separating

1 from the Armed Forces translate to credentialed ci-  
2 vilian employment in air traffic control occupations;

3 (2) that exist to the standardization among the  
4 Armed Forces of military controller credentials and  
5 experience and the alignment of such credentials and  
6 experience to credentialed civilian employment in air  
7 traffic control occupations; and

8 (3) that exist to ensuring members of the  
9 Armed Forces with military controller credentials  
10 and experience have earned the equivalent civilian  
11 credential prior to separation from the Armed  
12 Forces in addition to receiving their military creden-  
13 tials.

14 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
15 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary concerned shall  
16 submit to the relevant committees of Congress a report  
17 containing—

18 (1) the recommendations developed under sub-  
19 section (a); and

20 (2) a plan to implement those recommenda-  
21 tions.
