At the end of the bill, add the following:

DIVISION —NICS SYSTEM 1 2 ANNUAL REPORT TO CONGRESS ON ERRONEOUS 3 INELIGIBILITY DETERMINATIONS BY THE NICS SYSTEM 4 SEC. . Within 1 year after the date of the 5 enactment of this Act, and on July 31 of each succeeding 6 year, the Attorney General shall submit to the Congress a written report that contains a detailed review of all back-7 ground checks conducted by the national instant criminal 8 9 background check system established under section 103 10 of the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act that, dur-11 ing the previous 5 years, where people were initially denied from acquiring a firearm and then also those whose cases were deemed not eligible to for prosecution, including a 13 14 review of the process for making the determinations, each step included in that process, and a statistical analysis of 15 16 the age, race, gender, and national origin of, or any other identifying information provided on a Firearm Transfer 17 Record form (ATF Form 4473) about, the persons who 18 were initially denied and against whom cases were dropped

- 1 at each of the stages of review. A detailed summary should
- 2 also be provided on the cases during the previous 5 years
- 3 about the cases where convictions were obtained.
