At the end of subtitle D of title X add the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TRAINING PRO-
2	GRAM ON ANTISEMITISM.
3	(a) Establishment.—
4	(1) In General.—Chapter 80 of title 10,
5	United States Code, is amended by adding at the
6	end the following new section:
7	"§ 1568. Training program on antisemitism
8	"(a) In General.—The Secretary of the Defense
9	shall establish a mandatory training program for all per-
10	sonnel of the Department of Defense to—
11	"(1) promote recognition and prevention of
12	antisemitism and far-right extremism within the De-
13	partment;
14	"(2) educate such personnel on the history,
15	forms, and manifestations of antisemitism;
16	"(3) provide guidance on identifying antisemitic
17	incidents and language;
18	"(4) establish clear reporting mechanisms and
19	protections against retaliation; and

1	"(5) emphasize the impact of antisemitism on
2	military readiness, morale, and cohesion.
3	"(b) Sunset.—The requirement to provide training
4	under this section shall terminate on December 31,
5	2033.".
6	(2) DEADLINE.—The Secretary of Defense shall
7	establish the training program required under sec-
8	tion 1568 of title 10, United States Code, as added
9	by subsection (a) of this section, not later than 180
10	days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
11	(b) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date
12	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
13	shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the
14	Senate and the House of Representatives a report that
15	includes—
16	(1) a detailed description of the antisemitism
17	training program established under section 1568 of
18	title 10, United States Code, as added by subsection
19	(a) of this section, including—
20	(A) training content and learning objec-
21	tives; and
22	(B) delivery methods and platforms used;
23	(2) the total number and percentage of per-
24	sonnel who have completed the required training,
25	disaggregated by—

1	(A) civilian personnel and members of the
2	Armed Forces; and
3	(B) with respect to members of the Armed
4	Forces, Armed Force and pay grade;
5	(3) a list of consultants, organizations, or exter-
6	nal entities involved in the development or delivery
7	of the training; and
8	(4) an assessment of initial feedback from par-
9	ticipants and trainers, including pre- and post-train-
10	ing evaluations where available.
11	(e) Briefing.—Not later than July 1, 2026, the Sec-
12	retary shall brief the Committees on Armed Services of
13	the Senate and House of Representatives on implementa-
14	tion of this section and plans regarding continuing anti-
15	semitism training under section 1568 of title 10, United
16	States Code, as added by subsection (a) of this section.
