

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. GOLDMAN OF NEW YORK

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . REPORT ON FORCED CONSCRIPTION OF KID-**
2 **NAPPED UKRAINIAN CHILDREN INTO RUS-**
3 **SIAN ARMED FORCES.**

4 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 120 days after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
6 State, in coordination with the Secretary of Defense, and
7 the Director of National Intelligence shall submit to the
8 appropriate congressional committees a report that in-
9 cludes—

10 (1) a detailed description of Russia’s efforts to
11 conscript, mobilize, or recruit Ukrainian children
12 into the Russian armed forces, which includes kid-
13 napped Ukrainian children in Russia and Russian-
14 occupied territories of Ukraine;

15 (2) identification of the re-education camps and
16 military training facilities inside Russia and Rus-
17 sian-occupied territories of Ukraine that these
18 Ukrainian children have been sent to, including loca-

1 tions and descriptions of the conditions of these fa-
2 cilities; and

3 (3) an assessment of—

4 (A) the number of these Ukrainian chil-
5 dren sent to the frontlines in Ukraine to fight
6 on behalf of Russia;

7 (B) the number of these Ukrainian chil-
8 dren killed in combat or in Russian confine-
9 ment; and

10 (C) a projection of the total number of
11 Ukrainian children who will be conscripted, mo-
12 bilized, or recruited into the Russian armed
13 forces over the next four years.

14 (b) FORM.—The report under subsection (a) shall be
15 submitted in an unclassified form, but portions of the re-
16 port may contain a classified annex if the annex is pro-
17 vided separately from the unclassified report.

18 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
19 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
20 sional committees” means—

21 (1) the Committee on Appropriations, the Com-
22 mittee on Armed Services, the Committee on For-
23 eign Affairs, and the Permanent Select Committee
24 on Intelligence of the House of Representatives; and

1 (2) the Committee on Appropriations, the Com-
2 mittee on Armed Services, the Committee on For-
3 eign Relations, and the Select Committee on Intel-
4 ligence of the Senate.
